## II. DATA REGARDING PROPOSED PROJECT.

Description of the Project (Please provide a brief narrative description of the Project.):The proposed project consists of the development of a corner lot into a 15 apartment dwelling building. The proposed building would be approximately 15,000 SF, and feature three stories from the street level and two stories from the rear parking lot grade. The structure would from to Broadway, set close to the city sidewalk with three walk out units at street level, and parking on the middle level accessed from Glen Ave. The apartments would be considered market-rate, as there are no tax credits or other community housing funds for the project. The subject would be the second new building on the street since 2018, and would help to jumpstart the Broadway revitalization. The project is expected to serve the growing needs of the Regeneron work force, located just up the hill to the east, and to the community at large seeking a better standard in apartment homes than is presently available in the City of Rensselear, excepting a few recent projects. In the City of Rensselaer, the vast majority of the housing stock is over 50 years of age. The applicant respectfully seeks an 15- year PILOT fee agreement to off-set the significant tax burden that deters construction of the project. In addition, applicant requests an exemption of the Mortgage Recording Tax for the project, and a Sales & Use Tax for the materials, labor, rentals and equipment for the project.

Attached please find a completed revised Cost-Benefit Analysis, which updates the information contained within the Cost-Benefit Analysis originally submitted Todd Mr. Drake on behalf of PSR Holdings Two, LLC.

The revised Cost-Benefit Analysis reflects several changes to the originally IDA Application that were inadvertently omitted from our letter to you dated September 9, 2021. The additional changes to the original application and our September 9, 2021 letter are as follows:

- 1. The value of the sales tax exemption being sought is actually \$80,000.00. The budget numbers previously provided by Todd Drake are over a year old, and our numbers were done recently based on the current economic climate, and the historical reference we can provide from all of our multi-unit buildings that are currently under construction, and/or recently finished. Mr. Drake's construction budget number was \$1,934,790.00 and ours is \$2,466,000.00. The estimated cost of goods is around \$1,000,000.00, which is where we arrived at the \$80,000.00 figure. My attorney had previously provided Melissa Bennett with the amount of \$838,000.00 as the estimated costs of goods. This number was incorrect and was due to a math error on his part.
- 2. There was a typographical error in the PILOT Schedule previously provided. Specifically, the PILOT schedule was missing year No. 5. Below is a revised PILOT Schedule, which now includes year No. 5.
