RESOLUTION AMENDING A RESOLUTION ENTITLED "RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF DOCUMENTS IN CONNECTION WITH A LEASE/LEASEBACK TRANSACTION FOR A PROJECT FOR VALUSPACE TROY, L.L.C. (THE "COMPANY")".

WHEREAS, Rensselaer County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act") and Chapter 128 of the 1974 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting Section 903-d of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of commercial,

manufacturing and industrial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish its stated purposes, the Agency is authorized and empowered under the Act to acquire, construct, reconstruct and install one or more "projects" (as defined in the Act) or to cause said projects to be acquired, constructed, reconstructed and installed, and to convey said projects or to lease said projects with the obligation to purchase; and

WHEREAS, on September 14, 2017, the members of the Agency adopted a resolution (the "Approving Resolution") entitled "Resolution Authorizing Execution of Documents in Connection with a Lease/Leaseback Transaction for a Project for ValuSpace Troy, L.L.C. (the "Company")"; and

WHEREAS, subsequent to the adoption of the Approving Resolution, the Agency has been requested by the Company to reduce the employment level of the full-time construction jobs at the Project Facility per the correspondence attached hereto as Exhibit B (the "Request");

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF RENSSELAER COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The recital clauses to the Approving Resolution are hereby amended to include the following recital clauses:

"WHEREAS, on September 22, 2017, the Agency received a request from the Company to reduce the employment level of the full-time construction jobs at the Project Facility (the "Request"); and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Request, Exhibit A of the Approving Resolution needs to be revised;"

Section 2. Exhibit A of the Approving Resolution is hereby amended as reflected in the attached Exhibit A to this Resolution.

Section 3. Except as amended by this Resolution, the Approving Resolution shall remain in full force and effect and the terms and conditions thereof are hereby confirmed.

Section 4. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.

Jay,

I'm writing regarding the public benefits as described in Exhibit A of the Approving Resolution for our ValuSpace Troy project. Due to the specific nature/type of the project, several contractors that specifically service the self-storage industry are being utilized for the successful completion of large, labor-intensive portions of the work; i.e. metal building erection and the storage unit door fabrication/installation. While these contractors are not locally based and typically employ traveling crews, we have been unsuccessful sourcing the work locally. Furthermore, the traveling crews will generate additional business for local hotels, restaurants, etc. and associated tax revenues. As such, we respectfully request that the average FTE construction jobs created per Exhibit A(3) be adjusted accordingly. We would be propose applying a credit towards the required FTE construction jobs for out of area workers employed on the specialized contracts. We will otherwise make all reasonable efforts to create employment for local construction labor.
