RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR OF RENSSELAER COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING REGARDING A PROPOSED COMMERCIAL PROJECT TO BE UNDERTAKEN FOR THE BENEFIT OF METROPOLITAN LIFE INSURANCE COMPANY AND METLIFE SERVICES AND SOLUTIONS, LLC.

WHEREAS, Rensselaer County Industrial Development Agency (the "Agency") is authorized and empowered by the provisions of Chapter 1030 of the 1969 Laws of New York, constituting Title 1 of Article 18-A of the General Municipal Law, Chapter 24 of the Consolidated Laws of New York, as amended (the "Enabling Act") and Chapter 128 of the 1974 Laws of New York, as amended, constituting

Section 903-d of said General Municipal Law (said Chapter and the Enabling Act being hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Act") to promote, develop, encourage and assist in the acquiring, constructing, reconstructing, improving, maintaining, equipping and furnishing of commercial facilities, among others, for the purpose of promoting, attracting and developing economically sound commerce and industry to advance the job opportunities, health, general prosperity and economic welfare of the people of the State of New York, to improve their prosperity and standard of living, and to prevent unemployment and economic deterioration; and

WHEREAS, to accomplish its stated purposes, the Agency is authorized and empowered under the Act to acquire, construct, reconstruct and install one or more "projects" (as defined in the Act) or to cause said projects to be acquired, constructed, reconstructed and installed, and to convey said projects or to lease said projects with the obligation to purchase; and

WHEREAS, in April, 2021, Metropolitan Life Insurance Company and Metlife Services and Solutions, LLC (collectively, the "Company"), submitted an application (the "Application") to the Agency, a copy of which is on file at the office of the Agency, requesting that the Agency consider undertaking which Application requested that the Agency consider undertaking a project (the "Project") for the benefit of the Company, said Project consisting of the following: (A)(1) the maintenance, repair and replacement of an existing approximately 200,000 square foot facility and related improvements located at 500 Jordan Road in the Town of North Greenbush, Rensselaer County, New York (collectively, the "Facility"), including but not limited to repair or replacement of the roof, sidewalks and parking lots (such maintenance, repairs and replacements being collectively referred to as the "Facility Purchases"), (2) the maintenance, repair, replacement and upgrading of the mechanical, electrical, heating and air conditioning equipment relating to the Facility (the "Mechanical Equipment"), and (3) the maintenance, repair, replacement and upgrading of the computer equipment (including mainframe, server and peripheral computer equipment) relating to the Facility (the "Computer Equipment"), including, software systems, software licenses and maintenance/support, special project capability and programming services (the "Computer Purchases"), all as covered by previously issued interim sales tax exemption letters appointing the Company as agent of the Agency and as may be purchased from time to time under a multi-year capital plan of the Company (the Facility Purchases, the Mechanical Equipment and the Computer Equipment, together with the Computer Purchases, being collectively referred to as the "Improvements") (the Facility and the Improvements being collectively referred to as the "Project Facility"), all of the foregoing to be owned and operated by the Company as an information systems computer center and related uses; (B) the granting of certain "financial assistance" (within the meaning of Section 854(14) of the Act) with respect to the foregoing, including potential exemptions from certain sales and use taxes (collectively, the "Financial Assistance"); and (C) the lease (with an obligation to purchase) or sale of the Project Facility to the Company or such other person as may be designated by the Company and agreed upon by the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 859-a of the Act, prior to the Agency providing any "financial assistance" (as defined in the Act) of more than \$100,000 to any project, the Agency, among other things, must hold a public hearing pursuant to Section 859-a of the Act with respect to said project; and

WHEREAS, the Agency desires to provide for compliance with the provisions of Section 859-a of the Act with respect to the Project;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF RENSSELAER COUNTY INDUSTRIAL DEVELOPMENT AGENCY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Agency hereby authorizes the Executive Director of the Agency, after consultation with the members of the Agency and Agency Counsel, (A) that due to the (1) ban on large

meetings or gatherings pursuant to Executive Order 202.1 issued on March 12, 2020, as supplemented, (2) ban on non-essential gatherings of individuals of any size for any reason pursuant to Executive Order 202.10 issued on March 23, 2020, as supplemented and (3) suspension of the Open Meetings Law relating to public hearings pursuant to Executive Order 202.15 issued on April 9, 2020, as supplemented, each as issued by Governor Cuomo, during the novel Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic, to establish the time, date and electronic method of either conference call or webinar of conducting a public hearing of the Agency to hear all persons interested in the Project (the "Public Hearing"); provided, however, when the ban is lifted or the Executive Orders are rescinded, the Executive Director shall establish the time, date and place for the Public Hearing, which Public Hearing will be held in a city, town or village where the Project Facility is or is to be located, (B) to cause notice of such Public Hearing to be given to the public by publishing a notice or notices of such Public Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation available to the residents of the governmental units where the Project Facility is or is to be located, such notice or notices to comply with the requirements of Section 859-a of the Act; (C) to cause notice of the Public Hearing to be given to the chief executive officer of the county and of each city, town, village and school district in which the Project Facility is or is to be located to comply with the requirements of Section 859a of the Act; (D) to conduct such Public Hearing; (E) to cause a report of the Public Hearing fairly summarizing the views presented at such Public Hearing (the "Report") to be prepared; and (F) to cause a copy of the Report to be made available to the members of the Agency.

Section 2. The Chair, Vice Chair and/or Executive Director of the Agency is hereby authorized and directed to distribute copies of this Resolution to the Company and to do such further things or perform such acts as may be necessary or convenient to implement the provisions of this Resolution.

Section 3. All action taken by the Executive Director of the Agency in connection with the Public Hearing with respect to the Project prior to the date of this Resolution is hereby ratified and confirmed.

<u>Section 4.</u> This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
