

## **RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AGENCY PARTICIPATION IN HUDSON VALLEY COMMUNITY COLLEGE FOUNDATION NETWORKING EVENT**

**WHEREAS**, Hudson Valley Community College plays a significant role in the economic development of Rensselaer County and the region, through its many educational and vocational programs, providing well-educated and skilled workers for industry and commerce; and

**WHEREAS**, the Hudson Valley Community College Foundation has a long and continuing history of supporting and improving the educational and vocational programs of the college, and thus continues to make significant contributions to economic development and the quality of life in the region, which include attracting and retaining a skilled workforce for industry and commerce in Rensselaer County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Foundation annually conducts a networking outing which brings together business people, developers and economic development professionals from the county and region, among others; and

**WHEREAS**, the Rensselaer County Industrial Development Agency (the Agency), recognizing the importance of its members and staff engaging with the development and business community in such networking events, and recognizing the services and benefits provided by the Hudson Valley Community College Foundation and the role such services and benefits play in attracting and retaining a pool of educated and skilled workers to the County and enhancing the quality of life for those workers; and the role which such services and benefits play in attracting industrial and commercial development to the County, has previously participated in the outing as attendee and sponsor; and

**WHEREAS**, the Executive Director has recommended Agency member and staff participation in this year's outing to be held July 12, 2021, at a cost of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00); and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Agency policy with respect to the expenditure of Agency discretionary funds, Agency staff have reviewed this proposed expenditure utilizing the Agency's evaluation worksheet, a completed copy of which is attached hereto, and have recommended Agency participation in the event in furtherance of the Agency's mission to promote economic development and job growth in Rensselaer County, and

**WHEREAS**, the Agency members have reviewed that staff evaluation and recommendation and do concur in the recommendation and do find that participation in the event will serve to advance the core purpose and objectives of the Agency as described in Section 858 of the New York State Industrial Development Agency Act, and will be a proper expenditure of Agency funds, now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, that the Rensselaer County Industrial Development Agency shall be and hereby is authorized to participate, through members, staff and guests, as sponsor and attendee of the outing, at a cost not to exceed Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00).



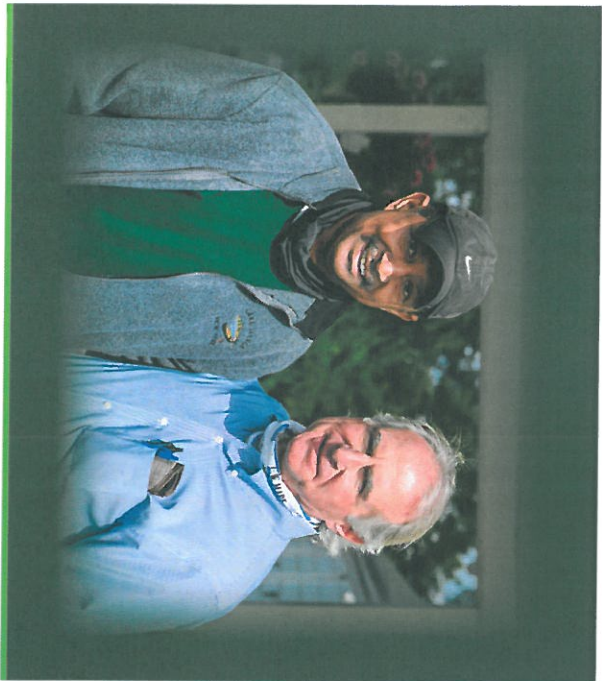
